Why Should I Be Baptized?

- 1. To follow the example set by Christ. "At that time Jesus came from Nazareth in Galilee and was baptized by John in the Jordan." (Mark 1:9)
- 2. Because Christ commanded it. "Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age." (Matthew 28:19–20)
- 3. It demonstrates I am a Believer. "We know that we have come to know him if we obey his commands." (1 John 2:3)

Why Be Baptized By Immersion?

- 1. Because Jesus was baptized that way. "As soon as Jesus was baptized, he went up out of the water." (Matthew 3:16a)
- 2. Every Baptism in the Bible was by immersion. (For example) "Then both Philip and the eunuch went down into the water and Philip baptized him. When they came up out of the water..." (Acts 8:38–39)
- 3. The word "baptize" means "to dip or immerse".
- 4. It best symbolized a burial and resurrection. "Or don't you know that all of us who were baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into his death? We were therefore buried with him through baptism into death in order that, just as Christ was raised from the dead through the glory of the Father, we too may live a new life." (Romans 6:3–4)

Who Should Be Baptized?

Every person who believes in Christ should be baptized. Believers realize their sin separates them from God. They conclude that Jesus Christ's death on the cross bridges the gap between them and God. Having decided to trust Christ alone for their salvation, they follow Christ in baptism as a symbol of their new life in Christ.

The Day of Your Baptism...

Please check in at the welcome center by 10:15am. They will direct you to one of the pastors to go over the plan with you so you are comfortable with what will be happening. It is important that you are prepared to share your testimony and to bring the following items with you:


- Clothes to be baptized in that will not be transparent when wet (a Made New t-shirt will be provided). Shorts are acceptable
- Water shoes or flip flops. Note: The ground will be slippery, so choose shoes with a good grip (optional)
- A change of clothes for after the baptism
- A plastic bag for wet clothes
- A towel
